## From the Pastor...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Trinity. The dogma of the Trinity is **not** one of those mysteries that we can be confident we will come to understand in this life, but it is important to have a basic understanding of the dogma. So, what is the dogma of the Trinity? Simply put, it is that there are three persons in one God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

The doctrine and theology of the Trinity has raised many debates and controversies throughout the history of the church. For some, it could best be termed “*confused*,” because they found it absolutely incomprehensible. How can there be three individual persons in one God? They angrily question. Yet, for others because it is incomprehensible, it has been tagged a “*mystery*”. This terrain is therefore not to be walked by those who walk by sight or as Paul puts it: “it cannot be unraveled by human wisdom or philosophy. It defies all forms of mathematical and logical calculations. Unfortunately, some who have attempted to unravel this mystery with mundane wisdom have been caught by the dangerous trap set by heresy. Although the name, Trinity, is nowhere mentioned in the scriptures, we know that Jesus commands us to: “Baptize them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28, 19; Acts 2, 38).

The Tradition and Magisterium of the Church teach that: “*The Divine Persons are relative to one another... Because it does not divide the Divine Unity, the real distinction of the persons from one another resides solely in the relationships which relate them to one another.... because of that unity the Father is wholly in the Son and wholly in the Holy Spirit...*” (CCC255). In light of this, the Trinity is a doctrine that holds that there are three distinct Persons united in one Divine Nature. This means that there are “three Persons in one God”.

There is no possible way for us to really understand the Trinity. What we do know is compiled from the Biblical references and the writings of early theologians who interpret these writings. How can one God have three Persons? We don’t know, but we are assured that it does and that it is Truth. We use all sorts of metaphors to help us to understand, but it is so out of our realm to grasp it, that we just have to accept it on faith and realize that when we talk about the Creator Father, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit, that we are talking about God. When we call out to One of the Three, we are calling out to the One God. In so many ways, it is not important for us to understand the workings of something so beyond our understanding, but that we simply realize that we can, through a relationship with any of the Three, have a relationship with the whole.... with God.

I wish you all your family a happy and blessed Solemnity of the Blessed Trinity.

Entonces, ¿cuál es el dogma de la Trinidad? En pocas palabras, es que hay tres personas en un Dios: el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. La doctrina y la teología de la Trinidad han suscitado muchos debates y controversias a lo largo de la historia de la iglesia. Para algunos, podría llamarse "confucion" porque lo encontraron absolutamente incomprensible. ¿Cómo puede haber tres personas individuales en un Dios? Ellos enojados cuestionan. Sin embargo, para otros porque es incomprensible, ha sido etiquetado como un "misterio". Por lo tanto, este camino no debe ser recorrido por aquellos que caminan por la vista o como lo expresa Pablo: "no puede ser desentrañado por la sabiduría humana o la filosofía. Desafía todas las formas de cálculos matemáticos y lógicos. Desafortunadamente, algunos que han intentado desentrañar este misterio con sabiduría mundana han sido atrapados por la peligrosa trampa tendida por la herejía. Aunque el nombre, Trinidad, no se menciona en ninguna parte de las Escrituras, sabemos que Jesús nos manda a: "Bautizarlos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo" (Mt 28, 19; Hechos 2, 38). La Tradición y el Magisterio de la Iglesia enseñan que: "Las Personas Divinas se relacionan unas con otras ... Porque no divide la Unidad Divina, la distinción real de las personas entre sí reside únicamente en las relaciones que las relacionan entre sí ... a causa de esa unidad, el Padre está completamente en el Hijo y completamente en el Espíritu Santo ... "(CCC255). A la luz de esto, la Trinidad es una doctrina que sostiene que hay tres Personas distintas unidas en una Naturaleza Divina. Esto significa que hay "tres personas en un Dios". No hay una manera posible para que podamos entender realmente la Trinidad. Lo que sí sabemos se recopila a partir de las referencias bíblicas y los escritos de los primeros teólogos que interpretan estos escritos. ¿Cómo puede un Dios tener tres Personas? No lo sabemos, pero estamos seguros de que lo hace y de que es verdad. Usamos todo tipo de metáforas para ayudarnos a entender, pero es tan extraño que lo comprendamos, que solo tenemos que aceptarlo con fe y darnos cuenta de que cuando hablamos del Padre Creador, Jesucristo y el Espíritu Santo, que estamos hablando de Dios. Cuando llamamos a Uno de los Tres, estamos llamando al Único Dios. En muchos sentidos, no es importante para nosotros entender el funcionamiento de algo que está más allá de nuestro entendimiento, sino que simplemente nos damos cuenta de que podemos, a través de una relación con cualquiera de los Tres, tener una relación con el todo Dios.

Le deseo a toda su familia una feliz y bendita solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad.
